## Community demands BNP official stays at the helm

Report by John MacLeod SCOTLAND'S biggest Trafalgar bicentennial celebration will go ahead despite a New Labour witch-hunt against the British National Party official behind the ambitious event.

Scottish BNP Secretary, Kenny Smith, set up a voluntary community group to celebrate the 200th anniversary of the famous battle - which ended Napoleon's dream of invading Britain. This followed an initial approach to the local authorities for an official celebration which fell on deaf ears.

With the help of colleagues from his local Community Council, of which he is Vice-Chairman, a neighbouring Community Council, Historic Scotland and a few other interested parties, Kenny has organised an event that is expected to draw in the crowds and bring enormous benefits to the Moray Firth area of the Highlands.

The event will take place at Fort George in Inverness on the 22nd of October and will feature a military parade with standard bearers and pipe band, commemorative service, naval display, RAF flyover and helicopter display, live traditional ceilidh and folk music, highland dancers, re-enactments and historical displays, children's entertainers, the Northern Constabulary's dog display team, a BBQ, and will end with a firework display.

Over 2,000 people are expected to attend the event that will bring social development and educational benefits to a deprived area.

Yet despite organising such a wonderful free event for the whole

Moray Firth community to celebrate our heritage and to remember the 4,500 Scots who fought for our freedom at Trafalgar - including the locally born assistant surgeon Niel Smith, who tended to the dying Nelson aboard HMS Victory – Labour Party activists attempted to scupper the community project, by demanding that Kenny was removed from his post simply for being a BNP official.

A media campaign against Kenny ensued but despite the efforts of hostile journalists, Labour Party councillors, MPs and MSPs and their bully boys, they failed.

The *Inverness Courier* was even forced to admit that they had taken a great deal of criticism over their campaign against Kenny as both the Community Council and Trafalgar at the Fort rallied unanimously to his defence.

Kenny said, "The support I have received has been overwhelming. Both the Smithton & Culloden Community Council and Trafalgar at the Fort are non-political, voluntary and non-profit making organisations, that aim to improve the lot of the whole community."

When quizzed on his BNP role Kenny added, "I am proud to be an official representative of the British National Party and I can honestly say that while I have never brought politics into either of these non-political organisations, I owe much of my community spirit to the experience and knowledge I have gained in the BNP. I believe it is essential that all our members should make a positive contribution to benefit their community in their home area."
