MEMORANDUM FOR : Director, Central Intelligence

SUBJECT : Soviet Surface-to-Surface Missile
Deployment (USIB-D-33.4/19)

1. Subject paper contains the results of the latest re-examination by OMAIC and its Deployment Working Group of all evidence concerning ICBM and MRBM deployment. It is pointed out that there are few ICBM site-complexes but a relatively large number of MRBM site-complexes in the "confirmed" to "possible" categories. These are included in Tables 1 and 2, as well as status of construction.

2. It is noted that some of the intelligence agencies concerned differ on the assessment of several sites, but there are no footnotes; subject paper averages the differences. In particular, the Air Force has more "probable" and "possible" ICBM sites than are indicated in this report. I believe that this paper is a long step toward getting agreement in the quantitative missile estimates.

3. Detailed revisions will be distributed to the holders of the TOP SECRET DINAR version of the deployment study. Limited distribution supplements will also be distributed to US

4. Recommend you support the paper, which requests the Board note the findings and certain administrative actions (Paragraph 4).
