The Central Design Bureau for Space and Intercontinental Rockets (Tsentralnoye konstruktorskoye byuro po kosmicheskim i mezhkontinentalnym raketam) is headed by Sergey Pavolovich Korolev. The bureau is located beyond Mytishchi, between Mytishchi and Podlinki, in Moscow Oblast.

Headquarters Comment: S. P. Korolev is listed in the Kremlevka as being on number 49-44, and he is indicated therein to be employed in the State Committee for Defense Technology [redacted] Korolev is also listed on pages 41 and 171 of the Academy of Sciences Directory for 1961 [redacted]. The above location appears to be in the immediate vicinity of NII-88.
