Annual contributions for assisted housing

Of the funds made available under this heading in Public Law 103-327 and any unobligated balances from funds appropriated under this heading in prior years, \$439,200,000 are rescinded, of which \$100,000,000 shall be from the modernization of existing public housing projects pursuant to section 14 of the United States Housing Act of 1937; \$150,000,000 shall be from the assistance for State or local units of government, tenant, and nonprofit organizations to purchase projects where owners have indicated an intention to prepay mortgages and for assistance to be used as an incentive to prevent prepayment or for vouchers to aid eligible tenants adversely affected by mortgage prepayment, as authorized in the Emergency Low-Income Housing Preservation Act of 1987, as amended; \$80,000,000 shall be from the lead-based paint hazard reduction program as authorized under sections 1011 and 1053 of the Residential Lead-Based Hazard Reduction Act of 1992; \$39,000,000 are rescinded from amounts recaptured during fiscal year 1995 or in prior years; \$21,000,000 shall be from Section 8 contract amendments; \$34,200,000 shall be from amounts reserved for lease adjustments; and \$15,000,000 shall be from amounts for the Family Unification program.
