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A Wonderful Supplication to be Read Specifically on Thursday Night

Whoever reads the following supplication ten times on Thursday night will have 1,000,000 good deeds written in his book of actions, 1,000,000 sins erased from his record of deeds and in Jannah, he will be raised 1,000,000 levels. Allāh has said in Ḥadith al-Qudsi that: *"I can not be considered as the Lord of My creations if I don't forgive him/her and raise him/her to the level of Ibrāhīm al-Khalil."*

يَا دَائِمَ الْفَضْلِ عَلَى الْبَرِيَّةِ. يَا بَاسِطَ الْيَدَيْنِ بِالْعَطِيَّةِ. يَا صَاحِبَ
الْمَوَاهِبِ السَّنِيَّةِ صَلَّى عَلَى مُحَمَّدٍ وَآلِهِ خَيْرَ الْوَرَى سَجِيَّةٍ وَ
أَغْفَرَ لَنَا يَا ذَا الْعُلَى فِي هَذِهِ الْعَشِيَّةِ.

Supplication to be Read on the Day of Friday to Become Free of Need or Want (of Others)

In the book *Muntakhab al-Misbāh* it is been narrated from one of the Maṣūmin that whoever reads the following supplication 70 times on the day of Friday – without doubt, three more Fridays will not pass except that Allāh will make this person free from need or want and (help) from others, Inshā-Allāh:

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الرَّحْمَنِ الرَّحِيمِ. يَا مُفِيدُ يَا غَفُورُ يَا وَدُودُ أَعْنِي
بِحَلَالِكَ عَنْ حَرَامِكَ وَبَطَاعَتِكَ عَنْ مَعْصِيَتِكَ وَبِفَضْلِكَ عَمَّنْ
سِوَاكَ بِرَحْمَتِكَ يَا أَرْحَمَ الرَّاحِمِينَ.

A Secret from the Secrets: Supplication to Meet Imām al-Mahdi Ṣāhib al-Zamān (may Allāh hasten his glorious return)

Whoever recites the following supplication in the below prescribed method for forty mornings will Inshā-Allāh, meet the 12th Imām.

During these forty days (mornings), the following supplication must be recited **17,488** times such that each day it is read **360** times except for the 10th, 20th, 30th and 40th day – on these days, the supplication would be read **1132** times. The below conditions must also be observed:

1. The person must be in a state of purity (Wudhū', Ghusl, or Tayammum).
2. The person must sit facing the Qiblah on a pure, clean place.
3. The person must first start by sending a Salawāt on the Prophet and his family.
4. He must ask forgiveness for his previous sins.
5. He must read the below supplication once:

يَا مَنْ هُوَ أَقْرَبُ إِلَيَّ مِنْ حَبْلِ الْوَرِيدِ. يَا مَنْ هُوَ فَعَالٌ لِمَا يُرِيدُ.
يَا مَنْ يَحُولُ بَيْنَ الْمَرْءِ وَقَلْبِهِ. يَا مَنْ هُوَ بِالْمَنْتَظَرِ الْأَعْلَى. يَا
مَنْ لَيْسَ كَمِثْلِهِ شَيْءٌ وَهُوَ عَلَى كُلِّ شَيْءٍ قَدِيرٌ.

6. The main supplication which must be repeated (as mentioned above) is as follows:

يَا اللَّهُ يَا مُحَمَّدُ يَا عَلِيُّ يَا فَاطِمَةَ وَبَنِيهَا. يَا صَاحِبَ الزَّمَانِ
أَدْرِكْنِي. يَا فَارِسَ الْحِجَازِ أَدْرِكْنِي. يَا أَبَا صَالِحِ الْمَهْدِيِّ
أَدْرِكْنِي وَلَا تُهْلِكْنِي.

7. The person must recite Salawāt ten times on the Prophet and his family.
8. The person must recite Sūrah al-Fāṭiha and Sūrah al-Iklās once each.
9. If it is possible to recite al-Iklās more than once, then it is better since it contains the greatest name of Allāh.

Supplication to Fulfill One's Legitimate Needs and Desires

Whoever has any needs or desires that he wants to be fulfilled should recite a two Rak'at Ṣalāt and send its reward to Fāṭimah az-Zahrā and recite the following supplication in the Qunūt of the Ṣalāt:

اللَّهُمَّ بِفَاطِمَةَ وَآبِئِهَا وَبِفَاطِمَةَ وَبِعَلِهَا وَبِفَاطِمَةَ وَبَنِيهَا وَ
بِفَاطِمَةَ وَالسِّرِّ الْمَسْتُودِعِ عَلَيْهَا إِقْضِ حَاجَتِي وَصَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَى
مُحَمَّدٍ وَآلِ مُحَمَّدٍ.
